

ASHRAE Hawaii Ice Plant Tour at Mid-Pacific Institute

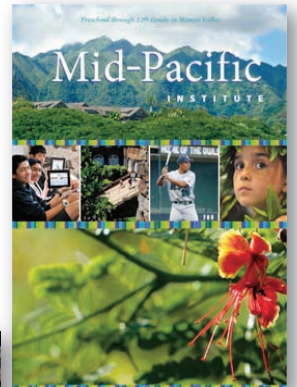
Join the ASHRAE Hawaii Chapter for a tour of the Ice Plant located at the Mid-Pacific Institute

Serving the Island community for over 140 years, Mid-Pacific Institute provides an enriching and diverse curriculum to students pre-school through high-school.

In 2007 the school plant completed a campuswide lighting retrofit as well as an expansion of the campus thermal ice storage plant.

The chill water piping system was looped between Plant I and Plant II. This now provides adequate capacity to cool the remaining buildings that do not have air conditioning.

Ice storage can be of great value to the building owner by reducing operating costs and earning LEED points. Ice storage has green connotations from an environmental perspective, and from a cost-saving perspective and is a value-engineered system in the true sense of the term.
